Initial Unemployment Claims 3/20/21



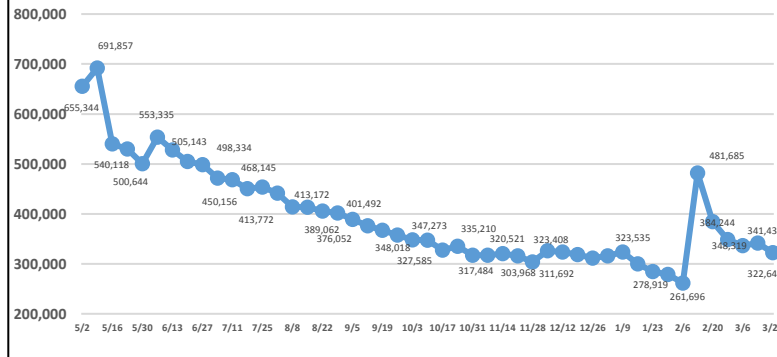

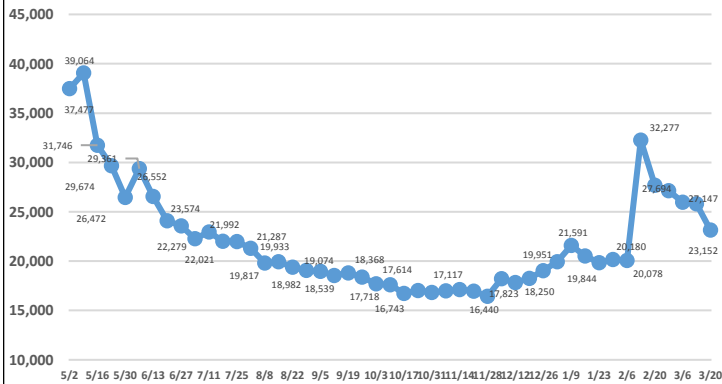

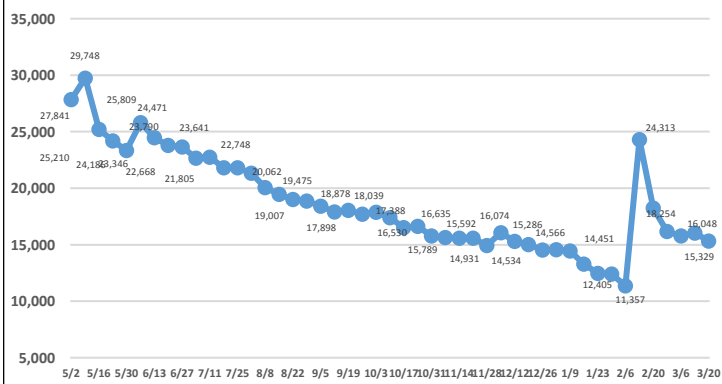
Construction Continued Claims



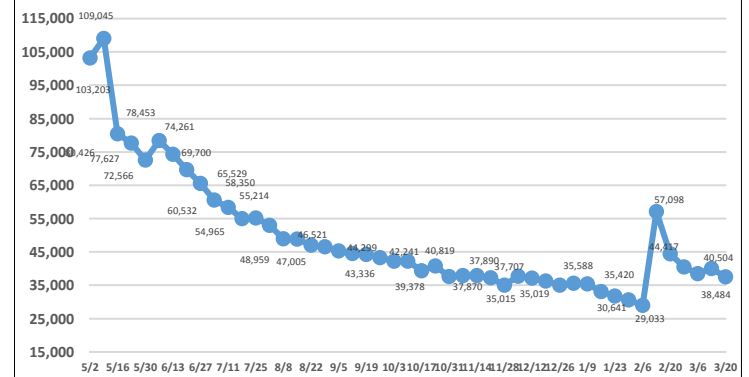
Manufacturing Continued Claims



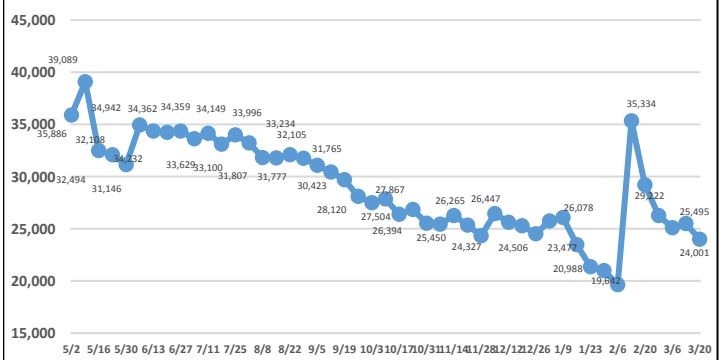
Wholesale Trade Continued Claims



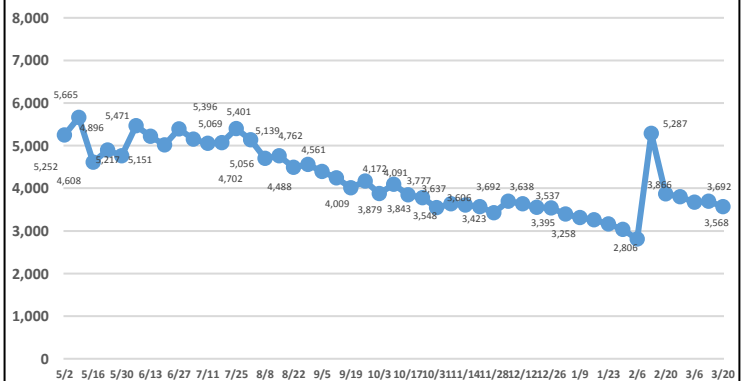

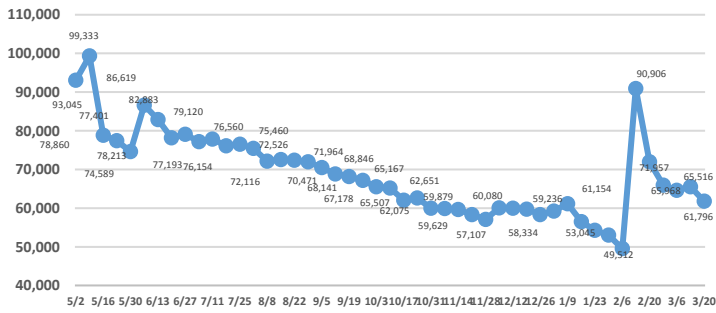

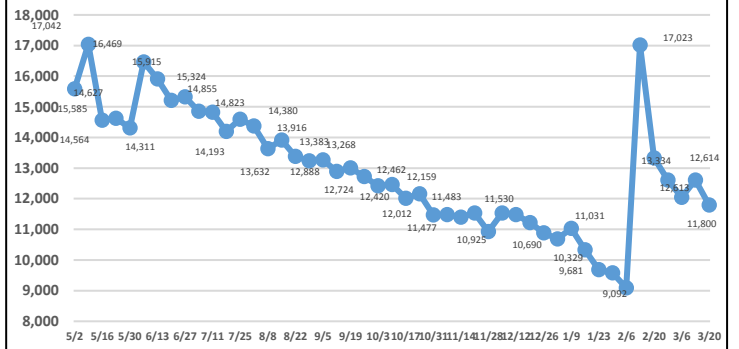

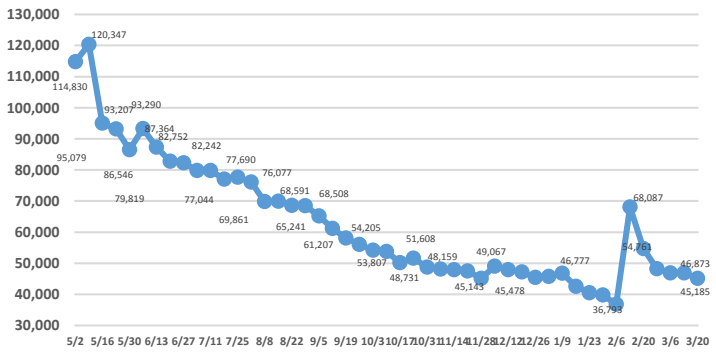

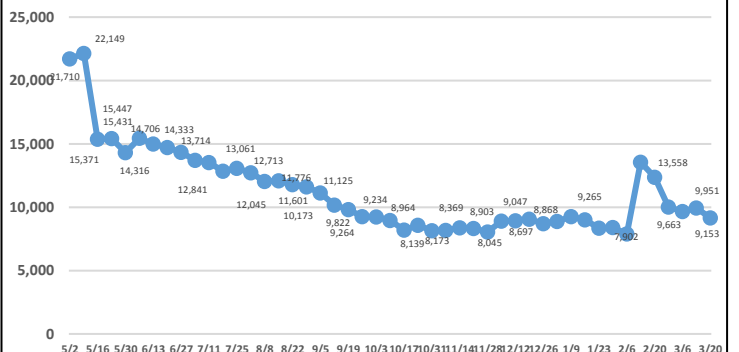

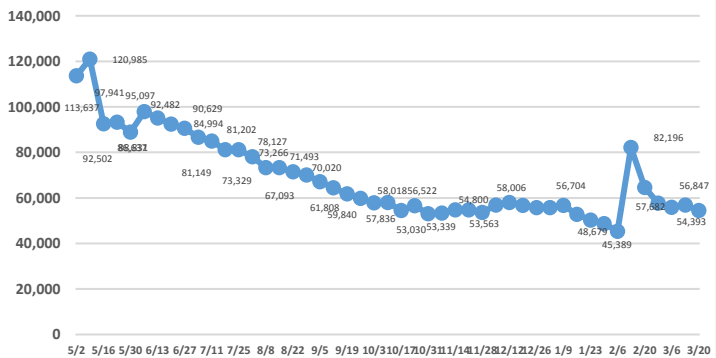

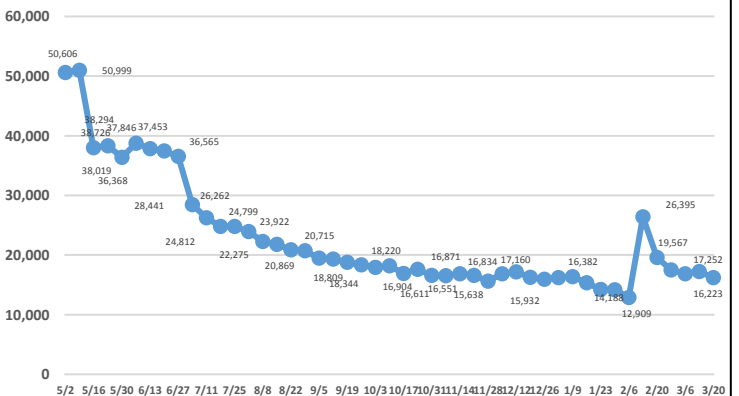

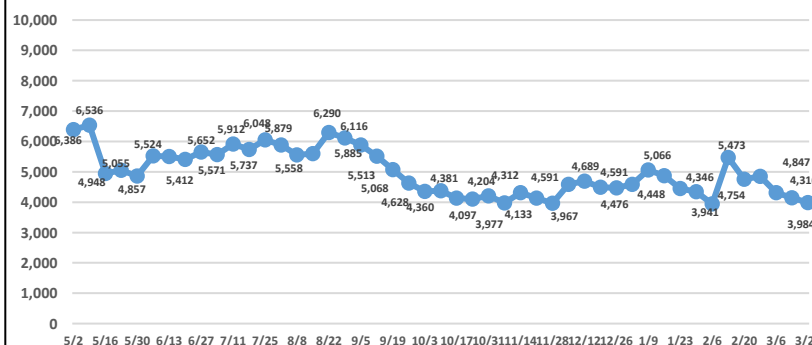
